Three leading universities in Sweden:
Chalmers University of Technology,
Royal Institute of Technology and
Karolinska Institutet have decided to
intensify their activities in China.

In late October 2005 two offices were officially opened by Ylva Johansson, Swedish Minister of Health and Elderly Care, and Xu Guanhua, China's Minister of Science and Technology.

The first is called “The Sino-Swedish Centre at Peking University” in Beijing.

The second is called “The Sino-Swedish Campus at Fudan University” in Shanghai.

The two officies will support both research cooperation and education cooperation using both researchers and teachers from the two countries.

In order to make this possible and efficient good networking facilities are needed between the two countries and their academic networks.
