

## The Call for Proposals for NDN2020 is now open.

Dear Colleagues,

The Programme Committee for NDN2020 invites you to propose presentations for the 31st NORDUnet conference.

NDN2020 is the Nordic networking meeting place, bringing together the networking community from Nordic universities and NRENs, along with their European and global colleagues. Our aim is to showcase Nordic, European & global collaborations, as well as future developments, current challenges and recent results within the topics and areas covered by the conference.

NDN2020 is also where we celebrate 40 years of NORDUnet. An impressive Nordic collaborative journey kicked off in 1980 which saw the first meeting for Nordic networking experts. From proudly promoting "Electronic mail", "Transmission of files in batches", and "more than 1 Megabit per second out of the Nordic countries", to having the five Nordic NRENs develop and operate the national research network infrastructures, connecting more than 400 research & education institutions with more than 1,2 million users, and reaching towards the global community.

The NORDUnet 2020 Conference will take place in Reykjavik, Iceland, on 15-17 September, 2020. The conference aims at covering all aspects of NREN activities, including but not limited to Campus Networking, Educational Services, Evolution of Networks, Network Automation, Security and Privacy, Identity Management, Services for HPC and Data Driven Science, Automation and Failure Prediction.

The conference programme will be made up of keynote talks, lightning talks, invited and submitted presentations. The Programme Committee invites talks on technical developments, new services, advanced applications of research and education networks.

Submit your abstract of 200-300 words to [submissions@ndn2020.net](mailto:submissions@ndn2020.net) . The submission should state: *Author, Presenter, Affiliations*, and *Title* of the presentation and be in pdf or Word format.

Proposal deadline is **Tuesday, 3 March 2020**.
